Mayor McDermott thanked Clerk-Treasurer Barnett for the excellent job done on preparing the Board with a booklet of facts and figures in order to provide all of the background information on the budget.

- Separated the Code Enforcement staff from the Building Inspector and the Fire Marshall
- Will be paving Richland Blvd but have not yet identified the other road that will be paid.
 The engineer is helping to identify the next road to be paved
- The \$100,000 grant from Senator Boyle is stalled in the budget office due to the passing of the State budget. The Village is still waiting for the contract
- Moving all of the Capital Projects, such as paving, DPW Building, dump truck, to the Capital Budget since the projects could cross over several fiscal years
- The Village is now paying \$2.05 a gallon for gas through the Town and \$2.43 per gallon
 of diesel. Pay back for the fuel rings to allow the Village to use the Town's gas will be 7
 months
