At 8:04 pm, Mayor McNulty called the meeting to order followed by a salute to the flag. After the Pledge of Allegiance, a motion to approve the minutes of December 7, 2009 as written was offered by Tr. Charles Fischer, seconded by Tr. Robert Fischer and all approved 5/0.

Suffolk County Police Dept. Third Precinct

No Police officer was present at this meeting and the incident report for the month of December had been received and distributed to the board.

Trustee Reports

<u>Highway Dept.</u>

Tr. Bob Fischer read his report for this meeting.....

Christmas decorations were completed.

Drains were cleaned during heavy rains in the early part of December.

Completed restoration work on Peters Boulevard in preparation to overlay road in the spring.

Regular cold patch maintenance and sign replacement work done throughout village.

Snow plowing during the storm went well. We put down approximately 51.20 cubic yards of salt/sand. We had crews come in during the evening hours to remove snow in the business district. We ordered and replaced out salt supply in preparation of any future bad weather.

Tr. Bob Fischer also added that not all drivers make a complete stop at our stop signs and encouraged all in the audience to "I stop here because I live here" and to tell your neighbors, family and friends to do so too.

Lakes and Parks

Tr. Belford wanted to thank the village highway dept. for doing a fine job in plowing the snow off our roadways. Also, she wanted to thank Judy Sallie for getting new Christmas decorations sprays for the business district area. She also mentioned that the Parks Committee will be having a meeting on Saturday, January 30th at 9:00 a.m. at the Wohseepee Park Cabin. Administration

Tr. Charles Fischer moved to approve Abstract Report #3306 for accounts payable vouchers totaling \$76,372.41 - The primary driver this month was the payment of \$60,000 for the ambulance contract, - other wise business is as usual and Tr. Belford seconded and abstract was approved for payment 5/0.

<u>Security</u>

Tr. Valdini mentioned that in the downtown four corners business district the orange cones in the crosswalks have proved successful.

Also, when we have a snowstorm the business owners are responsible for clearing their sidewalks in front of their businesses. However, the village highway dept. came in after business hours making it easier to clear sidewalks and curbs.

We had another incident of graffiti on the Chinese restaurant side and he contacted resident painter, Bob Neill, and we split the cost to cover it up and it took an hour and a half.

The Fortune Nail business violations are ongoing, even though the Fire Marshall states everything is okay. (Note: Fire Marshall doesn't enforce signage.)
