At 8:05 pm, Mayor McNulty called the meeting to order followed by a salute to the flag. After the Pledge of Allegiance, a motion to approve the minutes of August 4, 2008 as written was offered by Tr. Charles Fischer, seconded by Tr. Bob Fischer and all approved 3/0.

Suffolk County Police Dept. Third Precinct

Trustee Reports

Highway Dept.

Tr. Bob Fischer read his report for this meeting....

Seaweed was cleaned daily from Walker Beach.

Walker Beach is officially closed for the summer season. It will remain open on nice days for residents and their children to utilize the playground and sand.

The summer help has finished up. They were an asset as usual.

Preparations are in effect to ready our equipment for snow removal.

Our tree program is getting finalized for fall planting.

Set up was done for the ice cream social, and the snapper derby during the month of August. Both events were successful and well attended.

Lakes and Parks

Mayor McNulty stated that all the lakes have been trimmed down and look nice. At the upper lakes there is a levy and we did get a DEC permit to dredge and we will go out to bid next month. At Duck Island the tree roots go down very far and thus making it difficult to do work there, i.e. bulkheading. Gilbert Park is pristine and beautiful. On Labor Day we had no lifeguards on duty at Walker Park beach. The Mayor apologized for this and stated that the older lifeguards had left for college earlier and the younger ones had family plans.

Tr. Bob Fischer stated that he had met with the Mayor and Tr. Charles at different times at the Wohseepee Park cabin to discuss refurbishment such as painting and landscaping before the leaves and snow fall.

Administration

Tr. Charles Fischer moved to approve Abstract Report #3127 for accounts payable vouchers totaling \$295,329.37 - The primary drivers were \$211,000 for the BSFD, \$33,000 for garbage collection, and \$40,000 for paving repairs at

various locations around the village, other wise business is as usual and Tr. Bob Fischer seconded and abstract was approved for payment 3/0.

Security

Tr. Thomsen was absent at this meeting. Mayor McNulty mentioned that he is trying to set up a meeting with Inspector Cuff from the 3rd Precinct and Tr. Thomsen and Tr. Bob Fischer will attend also. The Mayor said that Tr. Thomsen has been busy lately but hopefully we will meet within a couple of weeks.
