- Much of the month of January was filled with snow and ice removal. It was a very icy month to say the least. We put down 178.4 cubic yards of salt for the month.
- When weather permitted much cold-patch work was done.
 We actual used a pallet and a half to fill in the many potholes.
- Nosrekca Lake was dredged by D.F. Stone Contracting. Nearly 1,000 yards of silt was removed during the dredging.
- Duck Island was thoroughly cleaned and cut. We are in the process of getting prices on plantings for the island.
- Tree planting was completed by ADM Landscaping. Forty trees were planted throughout the village.
- Floor repairs were made to Wohseepee Cabin. We are in the process of getting price quotes for gutters for the cabin.

Nosrekca Lake Restoration Contract Bid Award

We had received two bids for this project. One bid was from Amma Construction Corp. for \$59,000 and the other was from D.F. Stone Contracting for \$13,234.
