- **Fueling of boats is strictly prohibited.** Gasoline or Diesel fuel isn't permitted to be carried onto boats from shore
- Boat owners are responsible for disposing of all trash. Please be considerate of homeowners and keep noise to a minimum at night.
- **Working on boat while moored is prohibited.** All boats must be kept in operating order. .

BRIGHTWATERS HARBOR 2020 RESIDENT RATES

Dear Resident:

Applications are now being accepted at the Village Office, 40 Seneca Drive, Brightwaters for the May 1st – Nov. 30th, 2020 boating season. **Applications must be received at the Village Office by the March 31st deadline. Slips will not be held/guaranteed for applications received after 4/1/20.** All applications must be complete, signed and accompanied by:

1. Boat registration in boat owner's name.
2. Car registrations of no more than two (2) resident vehicles.
3. Proof of Residency - Utility bill (PSEGLI, SCWA, Cablevision) in boat owner's name. **NOT A TAX BILL**
4. Certificate of liability insurance for \$100,000 in the boat owner's name and naming the Village of Brightwaters as additional insured.
5. Check payable to Village of Brightwaters for full amount.

*The above fee is for boats brought in prior to the May 1st opening date without permission and if a boat is left in the canal after the harbor closes, November 30th.

If you have a berth preference, indicate the berth number and east or west side of the canal. Berth numbers are attached to the bulkhead, two berths per pole. As soon as assigned, you will receive your copy of a signed contract, rules and regulations and **one** harbor-parking sticker for each of the permitted vehicle plate numbers indicated. The harbor parking sticker is to be displayed on the left rear bumper or rear window of your car and only one vehicle is permitted to park at a time. No commercial vehicles or boats are permitted in the area. **Fueling of boats or boat repairs are prohibited at all times.** Please read your contract to avoid any problems during the boating season. Infractions will jeopardize renewal of your contract.
