LOCAL LAW -2023

THIS NEW LAW SHALL REPEAL AND REPLACE SECTION 128-54, AND ADD THE NEW SECTION 128-54, AS FOLLOWS:

§ 128-54 - STORAGE OF CAMPERS AND TRAILERS

<u>FIRST</u>: A. No camper, camper trailer, mobile home, house trailer or utility trailer shall be stored outside any place in the Village on public property.

- B. A camper, camper trailer, mobile home or house trailer may be stored or parked outside on private property for up to seventy-two (72) consecutive hours only upon obtaining a permit from the Village Clerk. The fee for such permit may be set from time to time by the Board of Trustees.
- 1. Only one such vehicle per family may be parked or stored on a lot containing the dwelling unit for such family.
- 2. Such vehicle must be parked on a paved driveway.
- 3. The parking of such vehicle shall not preempt the use of space needed for the off-street parking of other vehicles as required by Section 128-18 of this code.
- 4. Such vehicle shall not be used for any residential purpose while parked or stored.
- 5. There shall be a limit of four (4) permits for the purpose of camper or trailer storage issued in any calendar year.

SECOND: Separability.

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this local law is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this local law.

This law is adopted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §§10(1)(ii)(d)(3) and 10(1)(ii)(e)(3) which permits villages to adopt local laws respective to their property, affairs, and government.

THIRD: Effective Date.

This act shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.
