LOCAL LAW 3-2022

INC. VILLAGE OF BRIGHTWATERS

THIS NEW LAW SHALL REPEAL AND REPLACE SECTION 128-52, AND ADD THE FOLLOWING:

§ 128-52 ILLUMINATED SIGNS

- 1) This section shall be applicable to the North, South and Central Business Districts.
- 2) No outside, <u>exterior or interior</u> signs may be erected or maintained unless a full description of the same is submitted to the <u>Village Building Inspector</u> and a permit for the erection and maintenance thereof is obtained. No neon signs utilizing exposed neon tubes shall be erected or maintained, and no flashing or moving neon or electric or similar signs shall be permitted. No spot or floodlights for the purpose of illuminating buildings or parking areas will be permitted, except when allowed as a special exception by the Board of Trustees upon application therefor, and then only upon the observance of the following conditions:
- A. All area lightings shall be provided by means of controlled light sources, such as enclosed-type floodlights, refractors or equal, **to** minimize **the** light shining above the horizontal line measured by the height of the equipment.
- B. Light from luminaries shall be controlled, if necessary, by means of louvers or **lighthoods**. No bare bulbs shall be permitted.
