ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

The total amount of Village taxes estimated by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brightwaters as necessary to be raised during the fiscal year beginning March 1,1917, and ending February 28, 1918, classified as follows: is:

- 1. STREET FUND, to be used in the following amounts for the following purposes:
 - (a) maintenance of streets and roads \$1.000.
 - (b) maintenance of parks 300.

(c) note for \$4,500 issued in anticipation of taxes to be levied for fiscal year of 1917-1918, maturing Jan. 1,

1918, with interest 4.635.

(d) interest on \$21,000 Paving Bonds and \$34,500 Dock Bonds (e) ordinary expenses 1,665. 500.

The following resolution presented by Trustee Snodgrass and seconded by Trustee Oddie was unanimously adopted, the vote being as follows: Ayes - Trustee Snodgrass and Oddie.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brightwaters, New York as follows:

I. There shall be levied, assessed and collected a tax for the fiscal

year 1917-1918, upon all the taxable property in the Village of Brightwaters which shall include the following items:

(a) The sum of \$6,800 to pay the indebtedness of the Village lawfully contracted, which will become due and payable during the fiscal year 1917-1918. as follows:

Interest on \$21,000 Paving Bonds 3630.

34,500 Dock Bonds 1035.

Tax Anticipation note due February 13th, 1918 500.

Tax Anticipation note of \$4500 with interest due Jan.1,1918 4635.

Total \$6800.

- (b) The sum of \$1,300.00, which is necessary to meet the expenditures from the Street Fund for the fiscal year, 1917-1918.
- (c) The sum of \$744.28 which is necessary to pay the salary of the Village Clerk amounting to \$244.28 and \$500 to meet the ordinary expenses of the Village for the current fiscal year and preceding fraction thereof.
- II. The tax herein authorized to be levied, assessed and collected to raise the sume included in Paragraph I, hereof, amounting to the sum of \$8844.28 shall be levied and assessed at the mate of 1.0263 plus mills upon each \$100 assessed valuation of taxable property in the Village of Brightwaters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brightwaters, that;

I. The duplicate assessment rolls of the Village of Brightwaters for the fiscal year 1917-1918 as completed by the Board of Trustees by the extension of and setting down in a separate column therein opposite each item of taxable property the sum to be paid as a tax thereon, is hereby in all respects confirmed.

II. The president and clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed respectively to sign and to attest a warrant in the form provided by Section 114 of the Village Law, which shall be attached to one of the duplicate assessment rolls and delivered therewith by the clerk

to the Village Collector.
